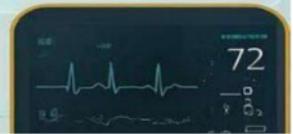
- To Detect silent diseases

21ST CENTURY

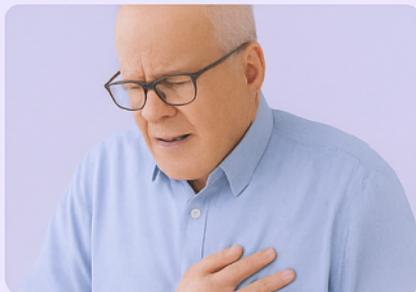
AI-powered diagnostics, wearable health devices, home tests, and national NCD programs transform preventive healthcare

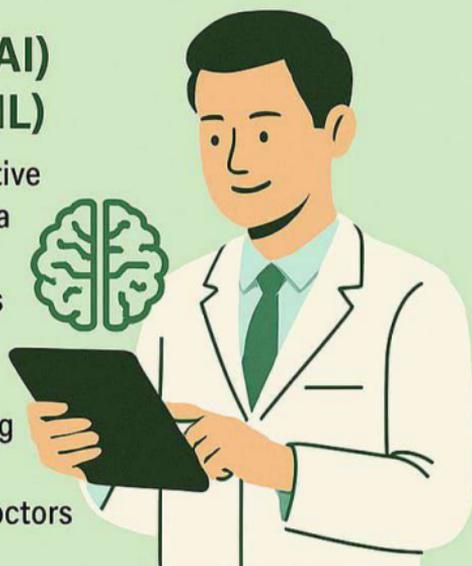
Lab Automation & Rapid Tests

Artificial Intelligence (AI) & Machine Learning (ML)

AI and ML are transforming preventive healthcare. They study medical data to find disease risks early — like diabetes, cancer, or heart problems — even before symptoms appear. Hospitals use AI tools to read scans and reports quickly, improving accuracy and saving time.

Early detection through AI helps doctors treat patients before conditions become serious.



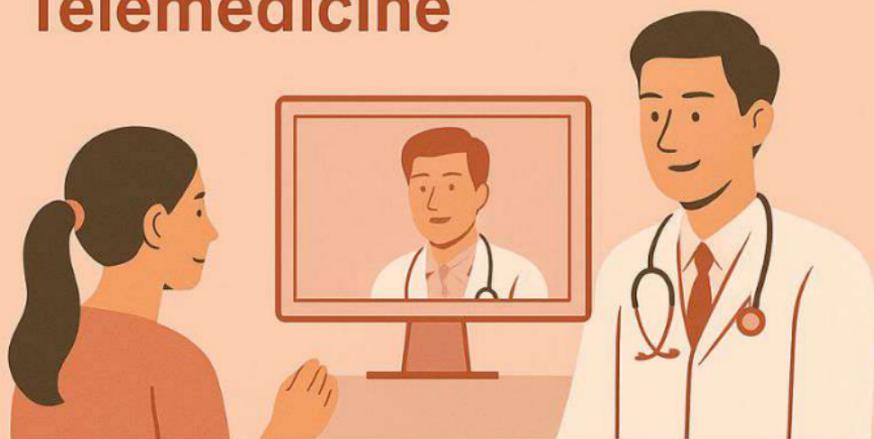
Wearable Health Technology

Smartwatches and fitness bands now play a big role in health monitoring. They track heart rate, blood pressure, oxygen level, and sleep quality in real time.

When something unusual happens, they alert the user for quick medical help. These wearables connect daily life with healthcare, helping people take charge of their health.



Telemedicine

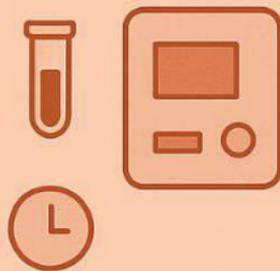


Telemedicine helps patients connect with doctors anytime, anywhere using phones or computers. It allows quick consultations, follow-ups, and sharing of reports without visiting hospitals.

This is very useful for people in remote areas or during emergencies. Early advice from doctors through telemedicine can prevent small problems from becoming serious.

Lab Automation & Rapid Tests

Modern labs now use automated machines that handle testing faster and more accurately. Automation reduces human error and speeds up diagnosis, so patients get results sooner. Rapid tests — like glucose, pregnancy, or infection kits —

COST OF DELAY
